Information

OUR LOCATION

Sheffield Hallam University is based in the heart of the country in Britain's fifth largest city. Major road and rail networks link Sheffield directly with the rest of the country and the city itself is served by excellent bus and supertram services. Our City Campus is directly adjacent to Sheffield's central Passenger Transport Interchange at Pond Street, and is a two-minute walk from Sheffield's Midland railway station.

RAIL LINKS

Regular inter-city services operate between Sheffield and other major towns and cities. The London journey takes around two-and-a-half hours, and Manchester, Leeds and Birmingham are an hour away.

ROAD LINKS

Sheffield is easily accessible by road with a dual carriageway link (A630) from junction 33 on the M1 directly to the city centre.

CAR PARKING



Disabled visitors are advised to phone before visiting so suitable parking can be arranged.

There is restricted parking on all campuses. Visitors are advised to use NCP or pay and display parking.

THE ROUTE TO CITY CAMPUS

From junction 33 of the M1, follow signs for A630 Sheffield City Centre. Continue on the A630 until the dual carriageway ends at a large roundabout with traffic signals (Park Square). Take the fourth exit from the roundabout signposted A61 City Centre, then take the third left into Arundel Gate, signposted A61 Chesterfield. Follow this road until the next roundabout, (Furnival Square). Take the first left, then the second left onto Arundel Street. The entrance to City Campus is straight ahead on Howard

There is an NCP car park on Arundel Gate and Eyre Street, there is also limited on-street pay and display parking on Howard Street and Arundel Street.

FIND YOUR WAY BY BUS

Bus routes to Collegiate Crescent Campus

For those visiting the Ecclesall Road end of the campus take the 74, 81, 82, 83, 84, 85 or 86 from Leopold Street, outside the Virgin Megastore. For those visiting the Clarkehouse Road end of the campus take the 50 (Dore) from the Central Bus Station or Church Street. The service 60 (Crimicar Lane) from the Passenger Transport Interchange will take visitors to the Royal Hallamshire Hospital which is a very short walk from Clarkehouse Road.

Bus routes to Psalter Lane Campus

Take the number 3 or 4 from the Passenger Transport Interchange (see City map).

CHESLEBEIETD CHAPEL-EN-LE-FRITH and the Psalter Lane Campus is approximately 1.2km ($^{3/_{\! 4}}$ mile) along Newfield Green roundabout. (1) Continue straight ahead (third exit) onto Psalter Lane After approximately 500 metres ($^{1/3}$ mile) you will come to a small **CAMPUS PSALTER LANE** and turn right onto Cemetery Road. Summerfield Street. 6 Continue up the hill to the next set of traffic lights At the first set of traffic lights (adjacent to Ward's Brewery) turn left onto St Andrews Flats **Clifford Road** exit signposted A625 (Castleton). Continue through traffic lights to the next roundabout and take the first At the second roundabout, take the third exit onto the ring road. Centre at the first roundabout (Furnival Square). **b∀**BK Ecclesall Road Medical Continue along the dual carriageway and go straight ahead (second exit) NOBEOTK The Crucible Theatre is on your right and the City Campus on your left. Brook **Norfolk Park** into Arundel Gate. 2 from the roundabout signposted A61 City Centre, then the third left turn St Wary's Road roundabout with traffic signals (Park Square). 🕕 Take the fourth exit CAMPUS Continue on the A630 until the dual carriageway ends at a large 9 House CKESCENT From junction 33 of the M1, follow signs for A630 Sheffield City Centre. 

From junction 33 of the M1, follow signs for A630 Sheffield City Centre. Continue on the A630 until the dual carriageway ends at a roundabout with traffic signals (Park Square). Take the fourth exit from the roundabout signposted City Centre, then the third left turn into Arundel Gate. 2 The Crucible Theatre is on your right and the City Campus on your left. Continue along the dual carriageway and go straight ahead (second exit) at the first roundabout. 3 At the second roundabout, take the third exit onto the ring road. 4 Continue through traffic lights to the next roundabout and take the first exit signposted A625 (Castleton). **5** Collegiate Crescent is approximately 750 metres (1/2 mile) along on the right.
